

Msgr. Robert Siffrin appointed as interim Head of Youngstown diocese



From a News Release from the Diocese of Youngstown

"A Catholic Diocese of Youngstown panel of priests has elected Very Rev. Msgr. Robert J. Siffrin to the role of diocesan administrator.

The diocesan administrator position will oversee the jurisdiction until the Vatican names a permanent successor for the late Bishop George V. Murry. A new Youngstown bishop likely won't be named for at least a year, diocese spokesperson Rev. Msgr. John Zuraw has said.

Siffrin, who is also administrator of St. Edward Parish in Youngstown, served under Bishop Murry as Vicar General and Moderator of the Curia. He was ordained in June 1979."
