

2021 Annual Bishop's Appeal Thanks to members of the Parish who have committed to this year's Appeal. As of May 12, 124 of our 633 families (20%) have responded with pledges for \$21,146 towards our goal of \$32,700 (64%).

We have received revised directives and guidance from the Diocese of Youngstown regarding the COVID pandemic regulations. Important information included in the new directives refers to the obligation to attend Mass as follows:

The Obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days is being reinstated the weekend of June 5/6 with exemptions for those who are ill, have significant health risk factors or those who care for someone who is compromised or ill. Also exempt are those with a *significant* fear or anxiety of contracting the coronavirus in a large group of people.

Those with these conditions should observe the Lord's Day and are encouraged to spend time in prayer on Sunday, meditating on the Lord's passion, death and resurrection. An appropriate way to do this is through viewing a broadcast of Sunday Mass.

NOTE: Mass that is broadcast through various media, including live-stream, is not intended as an alternative, nor does it fulfill the obligation for persons who are able to gather for a Sunday celebration and other Holy Days.

It is intended for the sick, homebound, imprisoned, etc. who are unable to attend Mass in person.
